



Trench Rammer 70kg - Instructions for Use

SAFETY FIRST

If you are collecting the equipment for someone else, please make sure this sheet is given to the equipment user to read. 	<p>Starting Procedure</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Turn ignition switch to "ON" position2. Turn fuel tap on (on some models)3. Engage choke (Cold start)4. Move throttle lever to Full throttle5. Pull starter cord with short sharp pulls until engine fires or starts6. Open choke as soon as engine fires or starts7. Restart engine if required (without choke)8. Move throttle lever to the idle position9. Allow engine to warm up
<p>Pre-Start Checks and Safety</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Check fuel tank is full of correct fuel• Check oil in compaction leg (sight glass on side of leg)• Check for loose nuts, bolts, screws• Use extreme caution and always be aware of ground subsidence with compaction vibration transfer• Ensure there are no foreign objects (i.e. wire, steel, electrical cables, water pipes etc buried shallow)• Keep children away from work area• Hold rammer with both hands• Make sure you have a firm footing when operating• Do not spill fuel• Do not allow inexperienced people to operate the machine• Ensure hands, feet and loose clothing are kept clear from moving parts of the rammer• Ensure the work area is clear of any obstacles, steep gradients or uneven ground	<p>When Operating</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hold rammer firmly with both hands• Move throttle trigger to full throttle• Note: These units are not designed to run at part throttle.• Proceed to steer rammer around area to be compacted <p>Stopping and After Use</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Idle engine2. Turn ignition switch to Off3. Turn fuel tap off
